1           A MOTION appointing committees to write the voters'  
2           pamphlet statements for the April 25, 2023, special election  
3           regarding Ordinance 19572 providing for the submission to  
4           the qualified electors of King County at a special election  
5           to be held in King County on April 25, 2023, of a  
6           proposition authorizing a property tax levy in excess of the  
7           levy limitation contained in chapter 84.55 RCW, for a  
8           consecutive nine-year period, at a first year rate of not more  
9           than \$0.145 per one thousand dollars of assessed valuation  
10          for collection beginning in 2024, with the 2024 levy  
11          amount being the base for calculating increases in years  
12          two through nine (2025 - 2032) by the limit factor in  
13          chapter 84.55 RCW, as amended, for regional behavioral  
14          health services and capital facilities to establish and operate  
15          a regional network of behavioral health crisis care centers;  
16          to preserve, expand and maintain residential treatment  
17          facilities; to provide behavioral health workforce supports;  
18          to provide mobile crisis care and post-discharge  
19          stabilization; to pay, finance or refinance costs of those

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20 projects; and for administration, coordination,  
21 implementation and evaluation of levy activities.

22 WHEREAS, K.C.C. chapter 1.10 provides for the publication and distribution of  
23 local voters' pamphlets in conformity with chapter 29A.32 RCW for elections held in  
24 King County, and

25 WHEREAS, RCW 29A.32.280 provides for each measure from a jurisdiction that  
26 is included in a local voters' pamphlet, the legislative authority of that jurisdiction shall  
27 formally appoint a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter approval of the  
28 measure and a committee to prepare arguments advocating voter rejection of the measure,  
29 and

30 WHEREAS, Ordinance 19572 provides for submission to the voters at the April  
31 25, 2023, special election, a proposed property tax levy in excess of the levy limitation  
32 contained in chapter 84.55 RCW, for a consecutive nine-year period, at a first year rate of  
33 not more than \$0.145 per one thousand dollars of assessed valuation for collection  
34 beginning in 2024, with the 2024 levy amount being the base for calculating increases in  
35 years two through nine (2025 - 2032) by the limit factor in chapter 84.55 RCW, as  
36 amended, for regional behavioral health services and capital facilities to establish and  
37 operate a regional network of behavioral health crisis care centers; to preserve, expand  
38 and maintain residential treatment facilities; to provide behavioral health workforce  
39 supports; to provide mobile crisis care and post-discharge stabilization; to pay, finance or  
40 refinance costs of those projects; and for administration, coordination, implementation  
41 and evaluation of levy activities;



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
