15 WHEREAS, on July 18, 2023, in accordance with K.C.C. 2.53.021, the
16 employment and administration committee reappointed Julie Kang to the citizens'
17 elections oversight committee, for a three-year term to expire on July 15, 2026;

Motion 16397 was introduced on 6/13/2023 and passed by the Metropolitan King County Council on 9/5/2023, by the following vote:


