4	WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the position of state Representative for the 48th
5	Legislative District due to the resignation of a 48th legislative district state representative,
6	who has been appointed by the King County council to fill the vacancy of a state senator
7	for that legislative district ("the vacancy"), and
8	WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the Washington state Constitution prescribes
9	the process for filling vacancies in either house of the state Legislature, and
10	WHEREAS, the candidates must reside in the 48th Legislative District and be of
11	the same political party as the legislator whose office is vacated, and
12	WHEREAS, the 48th legislative district Democratic Precinct Committee officers
13	have met to consider candidates for the position, and
14	WHEREAS the King County Democratic Central Committee has submitted the
15	names of three constitutionally qualified candidates to fill the vacancy for the remainder
16	of the current term as well as to fill the vacancy that will exist as of January 13, 2025;
17	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
18	A. Osman Salahuddin is hereby appointed to the position of state representative
19	for the 48th Legislative District in the Washington state House of Representatives for the
20	remainder of the current term as well as to fill the vacancy that will exist as of January

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- 21 13, 2025, and continue to serve until a successor is elected at the next general election
- and the successor has qualified.
