

1 WHEREAS, the existing ordinance authorizing King County
2 to contract with Metropolitan Transit Corporation to provide
3 transit services in certain areas of suburban King County will
4 expire October 1, 1971, and

5 WHEREAS, the maintenance of the existing level of public
6 transit service available to suburban King County is desirable
7 pending development of a County-wide system which may be operated
8 by the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle, and

9 WHEREAS, suburban cities have initially expressed
10 interest to join in a cooperative effort with King County to fund
11 the transit service,

12 NOW, THEREFORE, the King County Council declares its
13 intent to cooperate in a joint effort with suburban cities to
14 continue suburban transit service providing that the costs be
15 shared on the basis of the residency of the ridership utilizing
16 the contracted lines. Furthermore, the County Executive is
17 authorized to enter into such contracts with Metropolitan Transit
18 Corporation and the various suburban cities as are required to
19 implement the intent of this Motion.
