

MOTION NO. 2420

A MOTION expressing the County Council's appreciation to the Port of Seattle for its participation in the County's paramedic/mobile intensive care program with the Highline Service Provider Group.

WHEREAS, the citizens of King County have expressed time and again their desire to be served by a paramedic/mobile intensive care unit, and

WHEREAS, the County Council responded to its citizens by establishing a paramedic/mobile intensive care program, and

WHEREAS, the Fire Districts in the Highline area have joined together to form a Service Provider Group, and

WHEREAS, the Port of Seattle has agreed to be a part of the Highline Service Provider Group and to contribute \$20,000 to the program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Council hereby expresses its appreciation to the Port of Seattle for its decision to join the Highline Service Provider Group so that Seattle-Tacoma International Airport will be served by a paramedic/mobile intensive care unit.

The County Council further expresses its appreciation to the Port of Seattle for its contribution of \$20,000 to be used to purchase the mobile intensive care unit.
