A MOTION requesting the Executive to take action for King County to secure the long term use of Chelsea Elementary School from the Highline School District.

WHEREAS, King County is in the final stages of planning the Burien Governmental Center Complex, and

WHEREAS, the community planning process, including the input of Executive staff, has proposed that the unused Chelsea Elementary School facility owned by the Highline School District, would serve as an integral and excellent addition to the total plan of the Burien Governmental Center, and

WHEREAS, the Highline School District has declared that the Chelsea Elementary School facility is surplus to the educational requirement of the school district, and

WHEREAS, there exists an excellent opportunity to secure the long term use of the Chelsea Elementary School facility through negotiations with the Highline School District at terms mutually advantageous to both King County, the Highline School District and the Burien-South King County community,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Executive is requested and strongly encouraged to take whatever immediate steps are necessary to secure for King County the long term use of the Chelsea Elementary School facility, owned by the Highline School District, for use as an integral part of the planned Burien Governmental Center complex.
