MOTION NO. 7218

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make an application for funds in the amount of \$86,125 to support development of Supported Employment Pilot Projects to serve adults with severe psychiatric impairments in King County.

WHEREAS, the federal Rehabilitation Act Amendment of 1986, Public Law 99-506, authorized states to develop and provide supported employment programs for persons with severe psychiatric impairments, and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS), Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR) and Mental Health Division (MHD) entered into a collaborative agreement on September 24, 1987 to provide for the development of support employment programs as defined in the federal statute, and

WHEREAS, DSHS, pursuant to statutory authority, selected King County as one of six regions to participate in the pilot projects, and

WHEREAS, DSHS-MHD has made available up to \$86,125 for the period August 5, 1988 to August 15, 1989 for development of supported employment pilot projects in King County, and

WHEREAS, DVR will provide additional funding, beyond the program development grants directly to pilot projects for actual vocational services provided to eligible clients, and

WHEREAS, the pilot project will assist the county to expand services for persons who are chronically mentally ill in a manner consistent with the 1987-89 Biennial Mental Health Program Plan adopted by the council in Motion No. 6893 on June 2, 1987, and

WHEREAS, the Supported Employment Pilot Project will make available four percent of the program funds for King County costs for technical assistance, training, consultation and program evaluation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application on

1 behalf of King County for funds in the amount of \$86,125 to DSHS for the  
2 Supported Employment Pilot Project for adults who are chronically mentally ill.

3 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such  
4 applications and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the  
5 grantor.

6 C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute  
7 such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.
