A MOTION declaring the existence of an emergency due to concerns for public safety if there is a delay in determining the need for additional permanent jail capacity and how such need, if any, should be met; and waiving the requirements for the selection and award of professional and/or technical service consultant contracts for a phased environmental review.

WHEREAS, a delay in determining the need for additional permanent jail capacity and how such need, if any, should be met may adversely impact public safety; and

WHEREAS, the executive and the council have committed to conducting a phased environmental review of the master plans related to determining the need for additional permanent jail capacity and how such need, if any, should be met; and

WHEREAS, Motion 7914 requests the executive to submit a motion for concurrence of the council to hire an EIS consultant on an emergency basis; and

WHEREAS, the ordinary requirements for the selection and award of professional/technical service consultant contracts must be waived in order to prevent a delay in beginning a phased environmental review;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County Council declares that an emergency exists in King County whereby the public interest would suffer if there is a delay in contracting with a consultant to begin conducting a phased environmental review;

1 B. The ordinary requirements included in KCC Chapter 4.16
2 for the selection and award of professional and/or technical
3 service consultant contracts for conducting a phased
4 environmental review are hereby waived; provided that the WMBE
5 requirements contained in KCC Chapter 4.18 shall not be waived.
