A MOTION stating the order of county
issues on the general election ballot.

WHEREAS, the council has placed three issues on the
general election ballot this Fall for consideration by the
voters of King County, and

WHEREAS, these issues include measures that would approve
consolidation of METRO and King County, amend the King County
Charter in connection with the consolidation and a levy to
support a regional justice center, and

WHEREAS, the relationship between the consolidation
measure and the charter amendment will be easier for voters to
understand if they are adjacent on the ballot, and


WHEREAS, they will not be adjacent unless the council so

listed in the following order:


Proposition 1	METRO/King County Consolidation
