A MOTION waiving requirements for competitive 1 2 bidding and formal solicitation for the postearthquake repair projects. 3 4 5 6 WHEREAS, the King County executive issued a Local Proclamation of Emergency on February 28, 2001, under chapter 38.52 RCW and K.C.C. chapter 12.52, 7 8 and 9 WHEREAS, the metropolitan King County council adopted Motion 11124 on 10 March 5, 2001, extending until March 31, 2001 the waiver of the requirements for 11 competitive bidding or formal solicitation requirements for repairs to protect life and 12 property threatened by the emergency conditions cited in the Local Proclamation of 13 Emergency issued by the King County executive, which is attached to this motion and by 14 this reference made a part of this motion, and 15 WHEREAS, the King County Courthouse is the central administrative location of 16 all three branches of county government and many vital county offices and agencies,



including the King County superior court, the metropolitan King County council, the

The waiver by the executive, previously extended by Motion 11124, of requirements for competitive bidding of construction contracts under chapter 36.32 RCW, and of the requirements of K.C.C. chapters 4.04, 4.16, 4.18, 12.16 and 12.18 for any contract relating to postearthquake building repair activities, including, but not limited to, those buildings on the list in Attachment A to this motion, are hereby further extended until the completion of these projects.

	WHEREAS, the King County office of emergency management reported to the
	King County executive that beginning February 28, 2001, at 10:54 a.m., an earthquake
	occurred in the Puget Sound area. This earthquake, subsequently estimated at magnitude
	6.8, caused an emergency that required the closure of the King County Courthouse, and
	WHEREAS, an emergency waiver of competitive bidding and formal solicitation
	requirements of state and county law is necessary to assure the timely repair [of] the King
	County Courthouse and other county buildings and property, and

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WHEREAS, RCW 39.04.280 authorizes a local governing body by resolution to waive the competitive bidding requirements utilized when awarding contracts for public works, and contracts for purchases in the event of unforeseen circumstances beyond the control of the local government that either present a real, immediate threat to the proper performance of essential function, or will likely result in material loss or damage of property, bodily injury or loss of life if immediate action is not taken, and

WHEREAS, K.C.C. 4.16.050 authorizes the executive in the event of an earthquake to waive the requirements of K.C.C. chapters 4.04, 4.16, 4.18, 12.16 and 12.18 with reference to any contract relating to the county's lease or purchase of tangible personal property or services, to contracts for public works as defined by RCW 39.04.010 or to the selection and award of either, or both, professional and technical service consultant contracts;
