## AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A KING COUNTY BID BOARD

The County Council, pursuant to Charter Section 815, does hereby ordain and establish the King County Bid Board which shall consist of a designee of the County Executive, a designee of the County Administrative Officer and the Purchasing Agent of the County. Said Board shall have all of the powers and duties formerly held by the County Commissioners in connection with bid opening and the surveillance process in connection therewith.

All public notices of opening of bids shall be posted in the Office of County Administrator and in the Office of the King County Council pursuant to existing law.

The County Council finds as a fact that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
