

ORDINANCE NO. 01883

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE DISINCORPORATION OF FEDERAL WAY SEWER DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, by Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of Federal Way Sewer District, King County, Washington, said Commissioners have expressed a determination to disincorporate said Sewer District under the provisions of RCW 57.90, and

WHEREAS, Federal Way Sewer District is a "special district" within the meaning of RCW 57.90.010, has been inactive since its creation January 20, 1959 and has not, within the preceding consecutive five year period, carried out any of the special purposes or functions for which it was formed, and .

WHEREAS, Notice of Intention to Disincorporate was filed with the King County Boundary Review Board pursuant to RCW 36.93 and said Board did not choose to invoke jurisdiction and, therefore, said Notice of Intention was deemed approved, sixty days having elapsed,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED:

That Federal Way Sewer District, King County, Washington, is hereby disincorporated and that there are no assets or liabilities to be accounted for.

INTRODUCED and read for the first time this 14th day of July, 1969.
