

ORDINANCE NO. 00084 TO KING COUNTY CODE, RESOLUTION NO. 36096

WHEREAS, by R.C.W. 46.61.415 the County Commissioners have the authority to establish speed limits on county roads outside any incorporated city or town, and,

WHEREAS, by virtue of King County Resolution No. 36096, King County passed a comprehensive traffic code, and,

WHEREAS, certain speed limits set forth in Schedules 1 through 5 should be changed, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that pursuant to traffic engineering studies, Schedule 3 setting maximum speed limit at 35 miles per hour should be and hereby is amended to add the following streets:

112th Avenue Southeast, between Southeast 282nd Street and Southeast 304th Street

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of King County Commissioners that the maximum safe speed at which vehicles of any character may be operated on the described roads is hereby fixed as described.
