

ORDINANCE NO. 10128

AN ORDINANCE CONTINUING THE EXISTENCE OF ALL  
BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS FOR THIRTY (30) DAYS.

WHEREAS under Section 990 of the King County Charter all Boards and Commissions whose functions have not been transferred to another agency of county government are abolished after 120 days from the effective date of the Charter and,

WHEREAS the County Council requires additional time to make provision for such Boards and Commissions, and

WHEREAS, the County Council finds as a fact that an emergency exists and that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, helath, and safety, and for the support of County Government and its existing public institutions,

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED:

That all Boards and Commissions that would otherwise go out of existence under Section 990 of the Charter are hereby continued for a period of thirty (30) days.

INTRODUCED and read for the first time this 25<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1969.

PASSED by the Council at a regular meeting thereof on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1969.
