

ORDINANCE NO. 00133

AN ORDINANCE eliminating all existing stock restricted areas within King County and creating one district consisting of the whole of King County, except federally owned national forest lands, in which it shall be unlawful to permit livestock to run at large.

WHEREAS, due to the urbanization of much of King County and the decline of open grazing of livestock, the stock restricted areas (otherwise known as "non-herding districts") created between 1911 and 1944 no longer meet the animal control needs of the county; and

WHEREAS, the Humane Society is presently without legal authority to impound stray livestock in those portions of the county not designated as stock restricted, although in fact it is called upon from time to time to so act; and

WHEREAS, RCW 16.24.010 through .040 empowers the county to designate areas within the county as stock restricted; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of King County, Washington as follows:

Section 1. All of King County, except national forest lands owned by the federal government, is hereby designated a stock restricted area in which it shall be unlawful to permit livestock to run at large.

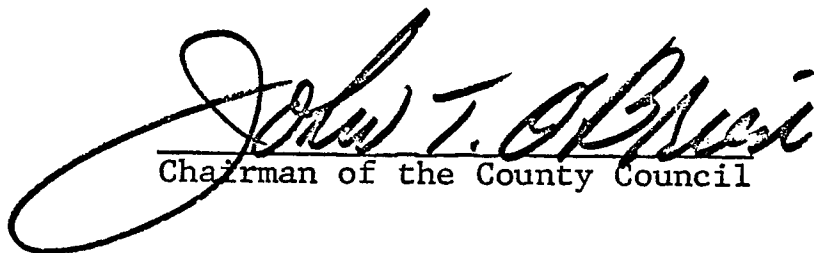

Section 2. All previous resolutions creating individual stock restricted areas are repealed.

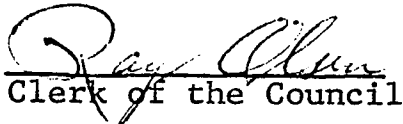
Section 3. Violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor punishable according to the provisions of RCW 16.24.040.
