

ORDINANCE NO. 00140

An ordinance relating to establishment of a Building Advisory Board and providing for Administrative hearings, providing for duties and powers of such Board.

Be it enacted by the County Council for King County, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby created a Building Code Committee, hereafter referred to as the Committee.

Section 2. The Committee shall be composed of seven individuals appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council, who shall serve for two year term or until their successor is appointed and qualified.

Section 3. Members of this Committee must be qualified by experience or education in the construction, building, architecture or engineering fields related to residential or commercial structures.

Section 4. The Committee will be responsible for analysis of and recommendations pertaining to revision, updating and modernization of the King County Building Code.

The Committee will review proposed changes to the Uniform Building Code and will advise the County Director of the Department of Building and the County Executive annually as to changes recommended to bring King County into conformance with it.

The Committee may be convened by the Director of the Department of Building to serve as an appeals board from administrative decisions regarding code enforcement, and appeals from the Committee's decision will be directly to the County Board of Appeals.

Section 5. The Committee shall serve without compensation.


