100th Avenue SE (SE 200th
Street to SE 204th
Street).
County Road

Survey No. 5-22-5-20

In the matter of the establishment of 100th Avenue S.E. (S.E. 200th Street to S.E. 204th Street) county road the Council finds as follows:

First. That the † Motion No. 128 therefore was * passed on the 19th day of January, 1970, and the County Engineer was duly directed to examine and if necessary survey the route of said proposed road.

Second. That on the 7th day of January, 1970, the County Engineer filed in the office of the Council his report in writing, and at the same time his field notes and profiles of the proposed road, and a map, as provided by law, and the 2nd day of March, 1970, was set as the day for hearing on said report, and notice of such hearing was duly given by publishing and posting as provided by law.

Third. That the Council, having considered said report and all evidence relative to the establishment of the road, and finding that such proposed road is a public necessity.

IT IS ORDERED BY THE COUNCIL, that the 100th Avenue S.E. (S.E. 200th Street to S.E. 204th Street) Road be established as follows:

Beginning at the West quarter corner of Section 5, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M.; thence Southerly along the West line of said Section 5 a distance of 1322.38 feet to a terminus on the centerline of S.E. 204th Street at the Southwest corner of the NW quarter of the SW quarter of said Section 5.

1322.38 feet - 0.25 mile

and as shown upon the field notes, profile and map of the County Engineer, and that from henceforth said road shall be a County Road of 60 feet in width exclusive of slopes for cuts and fills, and that the same be opened according to law.
