7	found by the King County Department of Building to be dilapidated,
8	fire-damaged, and vandalized
9	and generally in such a condition as to
10	constitute a public fire, health, and moral hazard; and
11	WHEREAS, Public notice and an opportunity to be heard
12	has been given to those persons having any known interest in such
13	premises, and a public hearing was held at <u>Seattle</u> , who on

16	NOW THEREFORE
17	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY OF KING AS FOLLOWS:
18	Section 1. That certain structures at 17041 28th Ave. N.E.,
19	Seattle, Washington.
20	described as follows: Lot 18, 19, & 20, Lake Forest Park 3rd Add.

23	King, State of Washington, has on it two dilapidated fire-damaged,
24	vandalized buildings and an accumulation of junk and debris. This
25	property has excessive overgrowth
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28	and is generally in such a condition of the
29	and is generally in such a condition as to constitute a public
30	fire, health, and moral hazard as reported by the King County Department of Building and by the King County
31	Department of Building, and by reason of such conditions said structures
32	and declared to be a public nuisance.
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1	Section 2. The owner and any and all persons having
2	any interest in said <u>structures</u> is hereby required
3	within Thirty (30) days from the effective date of this
4	ordinance to demolish and remove the structures and clean up the premises,
5	ap one premises,
6	so it no longer constitutes a public nuisance.
7	Section 3. If this ordinance is not complied with in
8	full, as specified in Section 2 above within Thirty (30)
9	days from the effective date of this ordinance, the Director of
10	Public Works of King County or his agent is hereby authorized
11	and directed to summarily abate the same as a public nuisance by
12	summary destruction and removal by such means
13	and with such assistance as may be
14	available to him. The cost of abatement shall constitute a debt
15	to King County and all costs and expenses so incurred shall be
16	and constitute a lien upon said real property upon the recording
17	of a lien notice in the King County Records and Elections
18	Department which lien may be enforced by proceedings provided by
19	law.
