

ORDINANCE

2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the participation of
3 King County in the Public Employment Program

4 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 Section 1. The Council hereby authorizes the County
6 Executive to act as Program Agent for the United States Depart-
7 ment of Labor Public Employment Program for all areas and
8 agencies within King County outside the jurisdictional boundaries
9 of the City of Seattle pursuant to the Emergency Employment Act
10 of 1971 and the administrative guidelines thereto.

11 Section 2. For purposes of administering the functions
12 of Program Agent for the Public Employment Program, there is
13 hereby created a special revenue fund to be entitled the "King
14 County Public Employment Program Fund."

15 Section 3. The functions of Program Agent for said
16 Public Employment Program shall be carried out by a Public
17 Employment Division within the County Administrative Office,
18 provided, that staff, operating and equipment costs of said
19 division shall be budgeted and expended within the fund created
20 in Section 2 herein.

21 Section 4. The Council hereby acknowledges revenue to
22 the King County Public Employment Program Fund from the United
23 States Department of Labor in the amount of \$1,190,600, for all
24 costs related to the Public Employment Program.

25 Section 5. The County Executive or his designee is hereby
26 authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$30,000 from the
27 1971 Special Programs Budget to the King County Public Employ-
28 ment Program Fund for supply, services and equipment costs as
29 the King County matching share for the Public Employment Program
30 administrative and support functions, said expenditure to be
31 considered a revenue to said King County Public Employment
32 Program Fund for the remainder of the 1971 budget year.

Section 6. The revenues specified in Sections 4 and 5 herein are hereby appropriated to the Public Employment Division within the King County Public Employment Program Fund for all costs of the Public Employment Program, subject to the conditions of Public Law 92-54; 85 Stat. 146 and in compliance with 29 A Code of Federal Regulations, Part 55, provided, that any uncommitted balance remaining in said fund at the end of the 1971 budget year shall be reappropriated for the 1972 budget year.

Section 7. All employees hired by the County under the Public Employment Program shall be compensated in accordance with 29 A Code of Federal Regulations, Part 55.3 (g) and the Office of Personnel shall establish appropriate methods and procedures for determining comparability between rates already established pursuant to Ordinance No. 685 for similar public occupations within the County.

Section 8. Ordinance No. 639, Section 3, is hereby amended to include the follow:

Public Employment Program Fund

(Public Employment Division) . . . \$1,220,600

Section 9. The Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for immediate preservation of the public welfare and for the support of county government and its existing institutions.
