

ORDINANCE NO. 967

AN ORDINANCE providing for the transfer of an appropriation from the County Road Fund, Solid Waste, to Current Expense Fund, Special Programs; the transfer of appropriations to the Department of Public Safety and Department of Parks; the transfer of an appropriation to the Solid Waste Disposal Operating Fund; and authorizing an additional appropriation and acknowledging additional anticipated revenue to Solid Waste Disposal Operating Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1; Paragraph a: The County Council finds that there exists a need for an additional appropriation in the amount of \$930,425 to the Solid Waste Disposal Operating Fund.

Paragraph b: Pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 800, relating to the implementation of a new rate structure for King County Solid Waste facilities, the Council hereby acknowledges the amount of \$430,425 in additional anticipated revenues.

Paragraph c: Pursuant to Section 2 herein, the amount of \$300,000 is transferred from the Department of Public Safety, Current Expense Fund, and the amount of \$200,000 is transferred from the Department of Parks, Current Expense Fund, to the Solid Waste Disposal Fund.

Paragraph d: The Council hereby acknowledges that all expenditures from the Solid Waste Disposal Operating Fund in excess of revenues from Solid Waste fees for the period June 1, 1971, through December 31, 1971, inclusive, is a debt owed to the Current Expense Fund by the Solid Waste Disposal Operating Fund; and such debt as is created shall carry an interest rate of three (3) per centum per annum; provided that any expenditure for an accrued tax liability payable to the State of Washington for a time prior to June 1, 1971 shall not constitute a debt by the Solid Waste Disposal Operating Fund.

Paragraph e: Ordinance No. 639, Section 5, is hereby amended as follows:

1 SECTION 2; Paragraph a: Chapter 25, Laws 1971, 1st Ex.
2 Session, provides that county road millage may be expended for any
3 service to be provided in the unincorporated area of the county
4 notwithstanding any other provisions of law.

6 to 1971 appropriations for the Road Fund is hereby amended as
7 follows:

19 Paragraph c: Pursuant to the adjusted Road Fund
20 appropriations set forth in Section 2, paragraph b, herein, the
21 amount of \$500,000 is hereby transferred to the Current Expense
22 Fund, Special Programs, Contributions to County Programs, to
23 provide services to the unincorporated area of King County.

24 Paragraph d: Pursuant to Section 2, paragraph c, the
25 amount of \$300,000 is appropriated to the Department of Public
26 Safety Current Expense Fund, and \$200,000 is appropriated to the
27 Department of Parks, Current Expense Fund.
