1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of
2 S. 138th Street (V-1405)

3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

4 SECTION 1: A petition has been filed requesting vacation
5 of the County road hereinafter described.

6 SECTION 2: The Council on the 30th day of August 19 71,
7 has declared its intention to vacate and abandon said road,

8 SECTION 3: Based upon the report of the Department of
9 Public Works, Utilities & Transportation the Council finds that
10 the road to be vacated is useless to the County.

11 SECTION 4: The Property Management Division recommends
12 that the portion described be vacated at no cost to the Corp-
13 oration of the Catholic Archbishop of Seattle (John F. Kennedy
14 Memorial High School) petitioner, as this portion was deeded to
15 the County for road pruposes by deed as recorded under Auditor's
16 #5842740.

17 SECTION 5: Due notice was given in the manner provided
18 by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the
19 13th day of September, 19 71.

20 SECTION 6: The Council has determined to grant said
21 petition. Those lands to be vacated are described as follows:
22 The S. 20 feet of that portion of S. 138th Street, which lies
23 between the centerline of 2nd Ave. S., extended Southerly, and
24 the East margin of 3rd Ave. S., extended Southerly (being also
25 described as the S. 20 feet of the North 30 feet of the South
26 Half of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 17, Twp. 23 N., R. 4 E., W.M.,
27 lying between the centerline of 2nd Ave. S., extended Southerly
28 and the East margin of 3rd Ave. S. extended Southerly, are hereby
29 abandoned, closed, discontinued and vacated as a public road.

30 INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 2nd day of
31 August, 1971.

32 PASSED at a regular meeting of the King County Council
33 this 13th day of Sept., 1971.
