

AN ORDINANCE relating to the application of Cascade Radio and TV Cable for a franchise to construct, maintain and operate transmission and distribution of television, FM radio and other audiovisual electric signals.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The franchise extends upon, over, along, underneath and across county roads, and rights of way existing now and as may be constructed in the future within the area described as follows:

- 1. Township 24N Range 8 East W.M. King County Sections 17,18,19,20,21,26,27,28,29,30,31,32, 33,34 and 35.
- 2. Township 23N Range 8 East W.M. King County Sections 3,4,5,9,10,11,12,14,15,16,22,23,24,25, 26,27 and 34. also 13.

SECTION 2: The above matter has come regularly for hearing before the King County Council and it appearing that:

- 1. The application was properly made.
- 2. The application was referred to the County Executive for investigation of the feasibility thereof and the checking of the plans and description of the location thereof.
- 3. The County Executive has made such investigation and has files with the Council his report and recommendation as follows:

- 4. Due and legal notice of said application and of this hearing thereon has been given by posting and publication in the manner and as required by law.

SECTION 3: The application of Cascade Radio and TV Cable is approved and the franchise is granted as approved. The same shall be

1 executed on behalf of King County by the County Executive.
