

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to a proposed  
2 amendment of Section 410, Article 4,  
3 King County Charter, submitting same  
4 to the voters of the county and  
5 establishing date of election.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 SECTION 1. There shall be submitted to the qualified voters  
8 of the county for their approval and ratification or rejection, at  
9 the next general election to be held in this county, an amendment  
10 to Article 4 of the King County Charter, amending Section 410  
11 thereof to read as follows:

12 ARTICLE 4, Section 410. Presentation and Adoption of Budgets.

13 At least seventy-five days prior to the end of each fiscal  
14 year, the county executive shall present to the county council a  
15 complete budget and budget message, proposed current expense and  
16 capital budget appropriation ordinances, and proposed tax and  
17 revenue ordinances necessary to raise sufficient revenues to  
18 balance the budget; and at least (~~forty-five~~) thirty days prior  
19 to the end of the fiscal year, the county council shall adopt  
20 appropriation, tax and revenue ordinances for the next fiscal year.

21 SECTION 2. The Director of the Department of Records and  
22 Elections shall cause notice of the proposed amendment of the King  
23 County Charter to be published in accordance with the state  
24 constitution and general law.
