AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of ROBERT MAIN ROAD (V-1385) -- Petitioner, Paul Van Leunen and others.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: A petition has been filed requesting vacation of the County road hereinafter described.

SECTION 2: The Council on the 12 day of September 1971, has declared its intention to vacate and abandon said road.

SECTION 3: Based upon the report of the Department of Public Works, Utilities & Transportation the Council finds that the road to be vacated is useless to the County.

SECTION 4: The Property Management Division can find no County record that disclosed any deeds nor an establishment of a road in this area. In view of the above it is recommended that King County vacate any right, title or interest that King County may have in the subject road and that the vacation be granted without cost to the petitioner.

SECTION 5: Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 27 day of September 1971.

SECTION 6: The Council has determined to grant said petition. Those lands to be vacated are described as follows:

All that portion of Robert Main Road, also known as County road No. 1067, lying within the South Half of the SE¼ of the SW¼ of Section 15, Twp. 26 N., R. 6 E., W.M., are hereby abandoned, closed, discontinued and vacated as a public road.
