1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of
2 ROBERT MAIN ROAD (V-1385) -- Petitioner, Paul Van Leunen
3 and others.

4 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1: A petition has been filed requesting vacation
6 of the County road hereinafter described.

7 SECTION 2: The Council on the 27th day of September 1971,
8 has declared its intention to vacate and abandon said road.

9 SECTION 3: Based upon the report of the Department of
10 Public Works, Utilities & Transportation the Council finds that
11 the road to be vacated is useless to the County.

12 SECTION 4: The Property Management Division can find no
13 County record that disclosed any deeds nor an establishment of
14 a road in this area. In view of the above it is recommended
15 that King County vacate any right, title or interest that King
16 County may have in the subject road and that the vacation be
17 granted without cost to the petitioner.

18 SECTION 5: Due notice was given in the manner provided
19 by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on
20 the 27th day of September 1971.

21 SECTION 6: The Council has determined to grant said
22 petition. Those lands to be vacated are described as follows:

23 All that portion of Robert Main Road, also known as
24 County road No. 1067, lying within the South Half
25 of the South Half of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15,
26 Twp. 26 N., R. 6 E., W.M., are hereby abandoned, closed,
27 discontinued and vacated as a public road.

28 INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 23rd day
