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AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of CHARLES SWINDELL ROAD (County Road #1029) S.W. 377th Street, First Avenue South and an alley. (V-1407) petitioned for by the Corporation of the Catholic Archbishop of Seattle, and others.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: A petition has been filed requesting vacation of the County road hereinafter described.

SECTION 2: The Council on the 27 day of September 1971, has declared its intention to vacate and abandon said road.

SECTION 3: Based upon the report of the Department of Public Works, Utilities & Transportation the Council finds that the road to be vacated is useless to the County.

SECTION 4: As consideration for the subject vacation the Corporation of the Catholic Archbishop of Seattle has granted to King County an Easement for Slopes, cuts and fills by instrument recorded on July 29, 1971 under Auditor's File # 7107290359, over, upon and across the West Half of the NW4, less portion lying North of the centerline of the vacated Road #1171, Established November 26, 1917, in Section 5, Twp. 26 N., R. 4 E., W.M., King County, Washington, less County Road, being strips of land lying Easterly of and adjacent to the Easterly right of way line of Meridian Ave. N., as surveyed by King County Road Survey No. 17-26-4-71 described as follows: Beginning at Sta. 143+25 at zero width; thence increasing to 3 ft., width at Sta. 143+50; thence increasing to 4 ft., width at Sta. 144+00; thence decreasing to zero width at Sta. 144+25; ALSO beginning at Sta. 146+00 at zero width; thence increasing to 4 ft., width at Sta. 146+50; thence decreasing to zero width at Sta. 146+75; ALSO beginning at Sta. 148+50 at zero width; thence increasing to 8 ft. width at Sta. 149+00; thence decreasing to 6 ft. at Sta. 149+50; thence increasing to 10 ft. at Sta. 150+00; thence increasing to 14 ft. at Sta. 150+50; thence increasing to 20 ft., at Sta. 151+00; thence increasing to 42 ft. at Sta. 151+75; thence decreasing to 15 ft. at Sta. 152+00; thence decreasing to 4 ft. at Sta.
