

AN ORDINANCE relating to CATV Franchise application fees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: There is hereby established a fee for reimbursement to King County for the administrative costs and expenses incurred in the granting of CATV Franchises.

SECTION 2: The fee provided for herein shall be \$300 for each separate application requiring an ordinance, whether a new franchise, amendment, or assignment payable at the time the application is filed with the Clerk of the Council. There will be no additional charges for advertising.

SECTION 3: The fee provided for above is not refundable even if the application is disapproved.

SECTION 4: The Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after approval by the Council.

SECTION 5: All payments received are to be forwarded to the Department of Revenue and credited to the County current expense fund.
