BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Any reference to the King County License Director,
King County License Department or Board of County Commissioners in
Title 6 of the County Code shall hereinafter be amended to read
King County License Division.

SECTION 2. Section 4, Resolution 36053 is amended to read as follows:

All applications for issuance or renewal of a pawnbroker's license shall be made to and be filed with the ((county-license director)) King County License Division on forms furnished ((by him)) for such purpose, and shall be accompanied by the required fee. This application shall state the true name of the applicant, who shall not be less than ((twenty-one)) eighteen years of age, the names of all persons having a financial, proprietary, or other interest in such pawn shop, together with such other information as the license ((director)) division deems appropriate. The application shall then be referred to the King County Sheriff's office for investigation, report and recommendation. If, from the reports and other information available, the ((board-of-county-commissioners)) King County License Division deems the applicant to be a fit and

All applications for issuance or renewal of secondhand dealer's license shall be made to and be filed with the King County license ((director)) division on forms furnished ((by-him)) for such purpose and shall be accompanied by the required fee. This application shall state the true name of the applicant who shall not be

less than ((twenty-one)) eighteen years of age, the names of all persons having a financial, proprietary, or other interest in such secondhand dealer's shop, together with such other information as the license ((director)) division deems appropriate. The appli-cation shall then be referred to the King County sheriff's office for investigation, report and recommendation. If, from the reports and other information available, the ((county-council)) King County License Division deems the applicant to be a fit and proper person, the ((council)) division shall issue or renew the license applied for.
