

ORDINANCE

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the codification
2 of the ordinances and resolutions of King
3 County, amending Parts I, III, VI (1) and
4 VI (8), Resolution 15273.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1. Part 1, Resolution 15273 is amended to read as
7 follows:

8 The playgrounds, community centers and other facilities of
9 the Department of Parks ((and-Recreation)) of King County, are
10 established by law for public recreation purposes. The public
11 recreation program consists primarily of activities planned and
12 directed by the Department of Parks ((and-Recreation)) and,
13 secondarily, of recreation activities of community groups brought
14 under the control of the Department when conducted under permit
15 at the public parks.

16 SECTION 2. Part III, Resolution 15273 is amended to read
17 as follows:

18 Groups which do not meet all of the requirements set forth
19 in Part II above, may be granted special permits by the ((Park-
20 and-Recreation-Board)) Department of Parks but will be charged
21 a fee. ((The-Board-of-County-Commissioners-has-authorized-the
22 King-County-Park-and-Recreation-Board-the-authority-to-establish
23 schedule-of-charges-for-special-services-in-recreation-facilities))
24 A schedule of charges for special services in county recreational
25 facilities will be established by the Department of Parks.

26 SECTION 3. Part VI (1), Resolution 15273 is amended to read
27 as follows:

28 The group using the facility for meetings, special events,
29 picnics, games, etc. agrees to hold the ((King-County-Park-and
30 Recreation-Board, Board-of-County-Commissioners)) King County
31 Executive, Council and the King County ((Park-and-Recreation))
32 Department of Parks free and clear of any and all claims for
damages or the loss of property that may result from an act or

1 omission of the applicant or his agents, while on park department
2 property.

3 SECTION 4. Part VI (8), Resolution 15273 is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Community organizations or individuals are not allowed to
6 establish regular charges for equipment, services, or concessions
7 on park facilities. Use of public facilities for private gain is
8 allowed only through concession contracts (~~(approved-by-the-board~~
9 ~~of-county-commissioners-)~~) by the County competitive bidding
10 procedures.
