1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of 96th  
2 Avenue N.E. (V-1354)

3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

4 SECTION 1: A petition has been filed requesting vacation  
5 of the County road hereinafter described.

6 SECTION 2: The Council on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of September 1971,  
7 has declared its intention to vacate and abandon said road.

8 SECTION 3: Based upon the report of the Department of Public  
9 Works, Utilities & Transportation the Council finds that the road  
10 to be vacated is useless to the County.

11 SECTION 4: The Property Management Division recommends that  
12 this vacation be granted at no cost to the petitioner.

13 SECTION 5: Due notice was given in the manner provided by  
14 law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the  
15 13<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1971.

16 SECTION 6: The Council has determined to grant said petition.  
17 Those lands to be vacated are described as follows: The West 30  
18 feet of 96th Ave. N.E. lying adjacent to the East line of Lot 12,  
19 Block 2, Fireside Addition #1, as recorded in Vol. 62 of Plats,  
20 Page 83 and 84 and the East 30 feet of said 96th Avenue NE lying  
21 adjacent to Lot 2, Block 3, Charlotte Addition as recorded in Vol.  
22 56 of Plats, Page 56, Records of King County, Washington and are  
23 hereby abandoned, closed, discontinued and vacated as a public  
24 road.

26 August, 1971.

28 12<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1971.
