AMMEDICACON DY:

 AN ORDINANCE acknowledging unanticipated revenue to the Seattle-King County Commission on Alcoholism: appropriating said revenue to the Seattle-King County Commission on Alcoholism for the Alcoholism Program Evaluation and Improvement Project; and amending Ordinance No. 639.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1. The County Council hereby acknowledges the commitment of \$24,075.00, from the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services, Health Services Division to the Seattle-King County Commission on Alcoholism for the continuation of the Program Evaluation and Improvement Project.

Section 2. The Council finds that \$12,037.50, of said funds are available for appropriation for the period July 1, 1971, through December 31, 1971. The remaining \$12,037.50, is available for appropriation for the period January 1, 1972, through June 30, 1972, in addition to any unexpended fund balance as of December 31, 1971.

Section 3. The Council finds an additional \$5,373.85, available for appropriation to the Seattle-King County Commission on Alcoholism, which is the balance of a previously separately administered account for the Commission's Evaluation Project.

Section 4. A supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$17,411 to the Alcoholism Commission is hereby approved and adopted, provided that said appropriation be utilized for allowable costs as provided in the agreement between King County and the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services, Division of Health Services for the Alcoholism Program Evaluation and Improvement Project.

Section 5. Ordinance 639, Section 2, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:
