An Ordinance relating to the provision of suburban transit service; establishing a King County Transit Division; and making an appropriation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1. There is hereby established a temporary Division of the Public Works, Utilities and Transportation, to establish and manage a public transit system in King County. Such Division shall terminate not later than July 1, 1972.

Section 2. The Division shall be known as the "King County Transit Division" and shall be authorized to contract for the lease of transit vehicles and to make all necessary contracts for the temporary operation of the system.

Service may be provided in the areas of north and south King County and Mountlake Terrace. The County Executive shall have the power to make route and schedule adjustments, additions and deletions.

Section 3. The County Council hereby approves and adopts an appropriation in the amount of \$40,000.00 for contractual services for the purpose of operating during the months of November and December, 1971. Such sum may be transferred by the County Executive from whatever unincumbered sources are available within Special Programs to the Special Programs - Transit Services account.
