

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the application of DOCKTON IMPROVEMENT
2 COMPANY for a franchise to lay down, construct, maintain and
operate a water system.

3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY

4 SECTION 1: The franchise extends along, under, and across
5 county roads, and rights of way existing now and as may be constructed
6 in the future within the area described as follows:

8 SECTION 2: King County Ordinance No. 00468, Amendment Ordinance
9 No. 529, and any other applicable County Ordinance must be complied
10 with by the Water District desiring said franchise.

11 SECTION 3. The above matter has come regularly for hearing
12 before the King County Council and it appearing that:

- 13 1. The application was properly made.
- 14 2. The application was referred to the County Executive for
15 investigation of the feasibility thereof and the checking
16 of the plans and description of the location thereof.
- 17 3. The County Executive has made such investigation and has
18 filed with the Council his report and recommendation as
19 follows:
20 for date of hearing
- 21 4. Due and legal notice of said application and of this hearing
22 thereon has been given by posting and publication in the
23 manner and as required by law.

24 SECTION 4: The application of DOCKTON IMPROVEMENT COMPANY is
25 approved and the franchise is granted as approved. The same shall be
26 executed on behalf of King County by the County Executive.

Legal description of Franchise Boundary

In King County, Washington, on Maury Island, in the vicinity of the Town of Dockton, an irregular area described as follows:

Portions of sections 29, 30 and 31, Township 22 N., Range 3 East W.M., bounded on the northerly and westerly sides by a line 50 feet outside and parallel with the government survey meander line of Puget Sound as shown on King County Assessor's maps, and bounded on the southerly and easterly sides by the following described line:

Beginning in the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 29 at the intersection of the shoreline of Puget Sound with the east margin of 95th Ave. S.W. projected northward, thence south along said east margin to the intersection with the Portage Dockton road, thence continuing south along the extension of said east margin to the centerline of S.W. 264th street, which is also the south boundary of the north $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 29, thence east 620 feet along said south boundary to the west margin of 93rd Ave. S.W., thence south 1331 feet to the centerline of S.W. 268th street, thence west to the section line between section 29 and 30, thence south 30 feet to the south margin of S.W. 268th street, thence in section 30, west 300 feet along said south margin to the N.W. corner of tax lot 36, thence south 633.34 feet to the S.W. corner of said lot, thence west 334 feet along the north boundary of tax lot 65 and 107 to the N.W. corner of lot 107, thence south along the west boundary of said lot to the S.W. corner thereof, thence west 663.92 feet along the south boundary of tax lot 64, to the S.W. corner of said lot, thence north 1270 feet more or less to the northwest corner of said lot 64, which is also the northeast corner of tax lot 35, being a point on the south margin of southwest 268th street, West and South along the south and east margin of S.W. 268th street, which is also known as Manzanita road, 2200 feet to the south boundary of section 30, Township 22 N., Range 3 east, thence continuing south in section 31, 700 feet along said east margin of Manzanita road to the north boundary of Tacoma Yacht Club Park, thence south in Tacoma Yacht Club Park along said east margin, to the north boundary of Tacoma Yacht Club, thence west along said north boundary 120 feet more or less to its intersection with the shoreline of Puget Sound.

The entire tract containing 300 acres more or less.
