ORDINANCE NO. ___1037

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election on the question of annexation and assumption of indebtedness to the City of Bellevue of unincorporated territory contiguous thereto.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The City of Bellevue by Resolution No. 1805 has determined that the best interests and general welfare of the City of Bellevue would be served by the annexation of certain unincorporated territory contiguous thereto as hereinafter described.

SECTION 2: On the 2nd day of April, 1971, there was filed with the City Clerk of Bellevue a timely and sufficient referendum petition calling for submission of the question of annexation and the question of assumption of indebtedness to the qualified voters within said territory.

SECTION 3: Said Resolution does satisfy the provisions of R.C.W. 35A.14.299, R.C.W. 35A.14.060 and R.C.W. 35A.14.070 and requests the calling of an election to be held among the qualified voters therein upon the questions of annexation and assumption of indebtedness.

SECTION 4: The King County Boundary Review Board by its decision dated August 25, 1971, approved the proposal as submitted all in accordance with R.C.W. 36.93.100; and, further, the time to appeal from such decision has expired.

SECTION 5: A special election shall be held on the 4th day of formulary, 1972, within the territory of the proposed annexation as hereinafter described for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors within the said territory the proposition of annexation and assumption of indebtedness of the said territory to the City of Bellevue.

SECTION 6: The boundaries of the territory proposed for annexation are hereby described as follows:
