AN ORDINANCE providing for continuity of the government of King County in event of an attack upon the United States or a major local disaster, implementing provisions to Chapter 203, Laws of 1963, State of Washington, and to Chapter 42.15 RCW.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Whenever, due to a natural disaster, an attack or an attack is imminent, it becomes imprudent, inexpedient or impossible to conduct the affairs of King County at the regular or usual place or places, the legislative body of King County may meet at any place within or without the territorial limits of King County on the call of the Chairman or any two members of the King County Council. After any emergency relocation, the affairs of the King County Council shall be lawfully conducted at such emergency temporary location or locations for the duration of the emergency.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and the support and preservation of King County and its public institutions, and shall take effect immediately.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 8<sup>th</sup> day of November 1971.
