ORDINANCE

NO. 1044

AN ORDINANCE acknowledging unanticipated revenue to the Civil Defense Fund; appropriating said revenue to the Civil Defense Division, Department of Public Safety; and amending Ordinance No. 639.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1. The County Council acknowledges that unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$67,302 from Federal funds will be received through the Department of Civil Defense, State of Washington, as reimbursement for Personnel and Administrative expenses for the Civil Defense Division, Department of Public Safety, for the period commencing July 1, 1971 and ending June 30, 1972.

Section 2. A supplemental appropriation in the amount specified in Section 1 herein to the Civil Defense Fund is hereby approved and adopted, provided that said appropriation be utilized to increase and improve emergency services of the Department of Public Safety and operational capabilities related thereto in compliance with the Federal Civil Defense Guide and other State and Federal regulations governing allowable costs for local Civil Defense personnel and administrative expenses.

Section 3. Funds appropriated in Section 2 herein shall not be expended unless the Office of Budgets and Accounts certifies in writing that funds are available and the Director, Department of Public Safety, and County Executive approve a plan of expenditure by the Manager, Civil Defense Division.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 639, Section 3, is hereby amended, in part, as follows:
