

ORDINANCE

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to and regulating the
2 design, construction, equipping, operation,
3 and maintenance of spray and wading pools,
4 public and semi-public swimming pools;
5 requiring plans and permits; establishing
6 safety, water quality and sanitation standards;
7 establishing a Swimming Pool Advisory Committee;
8 defining offenses and providing penalties and
9 amending Section 5 A, Ordinance 451.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

11 SECTION 1. Section 5 A, Ordinance 451 is amended to read as
12 follows:

13 A. It shall be unlawful for any person to open for use,
14 or allow or cause to be used any public or semi-public swimming pool
15 for swimming or bathing purposes without having a current, valid
16 permit to operate issued by the Director of Public Health. Applica-
17 tion for such permit accompanied by an annual fee of Seventy-five
18 (\$75.00) shall be made in writing to the Director of Public Health
19 on a form to be provided by him; provided that the fee for any
20 initial permit to operate shall be prorated on the basis of one-
21 twelfth the annual fee for each remaining month in the year and
22 provided that in any subsequent calendar year that a permit is
23 required by the terms of this ordinance and the public or semi-
24 public swimming pool is operated for less than six (6) months of the
25 calendar year, the permit fee shall be thirty-seven dollars and
26 fifty cents (\$37.50). The Director of Public Health shall inspect
27 the proposed public or semi-public swimming pool and upon determi-
28 nation that such swimming pool complies with applicable rules and
29 regulations and the provisions of this ordinance shall issue a
30 permit to operate to such applicant. Permits to operate shall
31 expire on December 31 of the year for which issued and shall be
32 renewable upon like application and payment of the annual fee.

1 Permits shall be valid only as to the swimming pool for which
2 issued, but upon application may be transferred without charge from
3 person to person. Permits shall be posted conspicuously on the
4 premises for which issued and shall be protected from the weather.
