

ORDINANCE
NO. 1064

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AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of a Stadium Steering Advisory Committee, defining its composition, duties and functions and repealing Ordinance 136 and K.C.C. 2.16.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established a Stadium Steering Advisory Committee, hereinafter referred to as the Committee.

SECTION 2. The Committee shall be composed of approximately twenty members, appointed by the King County Executive with advice and consent of the Advisory In-House Executive Committee, and confirmed by the County Council; one shall be a representative of the State of Washington to be appointed by the Governor of the State of Washington; one shall be the Mayor of Seattle or his designee.

SECTION 3. The Committee shall serve in an advisory capacity. Its function shall be to advise and assist the Advisory In-House Executive Committee in the development and execution of the Stadium facilities plans. The advisory functions of the Committee shall include:

- (a) Advise in selection of Project Manager candidates.
- (b) Make recommendations to the Project Manager and the Design Team on development of Stadium facilities.
- (c) Assist the Project Manager and other public agencies in the development and implementation of construction schedules.
- (d) Provide continuing review of progress of Stadium facilities project planning and construction.
