

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the application of WATER DISTRICT  
2 # 106, for a franchise to lay down, construct, maintain and  
operate a water system.

3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

4 SECTION 1: The franchise extends along, under, and across county  
5 roads, and rights of way existing now and as may be constructed in the future  
6 within the area described as follows:

7 Tract "A" - Beginning at the intersection of the W. line of  
8 Sec. 24, Twp. 21 N.R. 3 E, W.M. and the S'western boundary line of King  
9 County; thence SE'ly along said boundary line to point of intersection  
10 with a line 150' E of the E. line of the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of said Section 24;  
11 thence N'ly parallel with and 150' E. of said E. line of the  $W\frac{1}{2}$  of  $W\frac{1}{2}$  to  
12 a point 825' S. of the N. line of said Sec. 24; thence W'ly parallel with  
13 said N. line of Sec. 24 to the W. line of said Sec. 24; thence S'ly along  
14 said W. line to its intersection with the Southwestern boundary line of  
15 King County, also being the point of beginning.

16 Tract "B" The plats of Lakota and Lakota Div. # 2 in the  $NE\frac{1}{4}$   
17 of the  $NW\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 12, Twp. 21 N., R. 3 E.W.M., and in the  $SW\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 1,  
18 Twp. 21 N., R. 3 E.W.M., and the unplatted property bounded on the South by  
19 S.W. 304th St, on the East by Lakota Div. # 2, and on the North and West by  
20 Dumas Bay ( Puget Sound).

21 SECTION 2: King County Ordinance No. 00468, Amendment Ordinance  
22 No. 529, and any other applicable County Ordinance must be complied with by  
23 the Water District desiring said franchise.

24 SECTION 3: The above matter has come regularly for hearing before  
25 the King County Council and it appearing that:

- 26 1. The application was properly made.  
27 2. The application was referred to the County Executive for  
28 investigation of the feasibility thereof and the checking of  
29 the plans and description of the location thereof.  
30 3. The County Executive has made such investigation and has filed  
31 with the Council his report and recommendation as follows:
