ORDINANCE
NO. 1079

1 AN ORDINANCE acknowledging unanticipated revenue to
2 the 1971 King County budget and appropriating said
3 revenue to the 1971 Current Expense Fund and
4 amending Ordinance No. 639, and declaring an
5 emergency.

6 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

7 Section 1. The County Council acknowledges that unanti-
8 cipated revenue will be received through the Washington State
9 Bar Association for the Law Student Intern Program Grant...\$13,939

10 Section 2. A supplemental appropriation in the amount
11 of \$13,939, as specified in Section 1 herein, to the Prosecuting
12 Attorney's Office is hereby approved and adopted, provided that
13 said appropriation be utilized for payment of legal interns and
14 other allowable expenses as provided in the agreement between
15 the Prosecutor's Office and the Washington Bar Association.

16 Section 3. Ordinance No. 639, Section 2, as amended, is
17 hereby amended as follows:

18 Prosecuting Attorney ~~\$1,174,761~~ \$1,188,700

19 Section 4. The County Council finds as a fact and declares
20 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary
21 for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety
22 or for the support of county government and its existing public
23 institutions.
