AN ORDINANCE providing for an additional appropriation NO. 71-852  
in the 1971 King County budget, Prosecutor's Office,  
transferring funds from Current Expense Fund, Special  
Programs, Non-Departmental Programs and amending  
Ordinance No. 639, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1. The County Council finds that the Prosecutor's Office  
paid \$17,843 to terminating employees during the 1971 budget year for unused  
vacation time.

Section 2. That pursuant to the above findings, the County Council  
hereby approves and adopts an additional appropriation in the amount of  
\$17,843, to the Prosecuting Attorney's Office.

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 1. and 2. herein, there is hereby  
approved an appropriation transfer in the amount of \$17,843 from Current  
Expense Fund, Special Programs, Non-Departmental Programs, Salary Adjustment,  
to Current Expense, Prosecutor's Office.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 639, Section 2, as amended, is hereby  
amended as follows:

Prosecuting Attorney	\$1,188,790	<u>\$1,206,543</u>
Non-Departmental Programs:		
Salary Adjustment	\$84,259	<u>\$66,416</u>

Section 5. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an  
emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate pre-  
servation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county  
government and its existing public institutions.
