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SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE NO. 1085

AN ORDINANCE establishing the compensation to be paid County officers and employees.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The compensation to be paid all officers and employees of King County Executive and Judicial branches of government shall be those salary rates set forth in Ordinance No. 685 as amended and in effect on December 31, 1971, provided that the compensation to be paid the below listed officers and employees shall not exceed the annual rates specified:

Mgr, Office of Property	& Purchasing	\$19,500
Director, Department of	Finance	\$19,500
Prosecuting Attorney		\$27,500
Assessor		\$19,500

Automobile & Marriage License Manager \$15,000

SECTION 2. The authority of the County Executive to correct clerical errors pursuant to the procedures outlined in Ordinance No. 465 shall be and is hereby extended to include the 1972 budget and any salary and/or appropriation ordinances enacted pursuant thereto.

SECTION 3. Nothing herein shall limit the authority of the Manager, Office of Personnel, to reclassify any County officer or employee's position title and to establish salary payment procedures pursuant to Ordinance No. 422 and the "Administrative Procedures and Rules for the Career Service" approved August 28, 1970, provided the salary rate for any officer or employee reclassified shall be the same as that established herein and shall not be changed by virtue of said reclassification until such time as a pay plan is adopted by ordinance.

SECTION 4. Due to the expansion of the County Auditor's responsibilities in the area of developing issue papers, making special research studies, and carrying on liaison work with the State legislature, the salary of that office is hereby raised to \$22,500.
