

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of the PLAT OF MARMAK
2 (V-1413) Petitioner Onnie O. Makela and his wife, Martha
3 F. Makela.

4 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1: A petition has been filed requesting vacation
6 of the County plat hereinafter described.

7 SECTION 2: The Council on the 3rd day of January, 1972,
8 has declared its intention to vacate and abandon said plat.

9 SECTION 3: Based upon the report of the Department of
10 Public Works, Utilities & Transportation, and the Planning De-
11 partment, the Council finds that the vacation of the plat would
12 not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King
13 County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity
14 of the proposed vacation.

15 SECTION 4: The Property Management Division has appraised
16 the property and inasmuch as the subject plat was dedicated by
17 the petitioner, Onnie O. Makela and Martha F. Makela, his wife,
18 it is recommended that the petition be granted without charge
19 other than the \$100 deposited, which was submitted with the
20 application.

21 SECTION 5: Due notice was given in the manner provided by
22 law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the
23 3rd day of January, 1972.

24 SECTION 6: The Council has determined to grant said
25 petition. Those lands to be vacated are described as follows:
26 All the plat of MARMAK as recorded in Volume 89 of Plats, Page 81,
27 Records of King County, Washington, EXCEPT the West 12 feet
28 thereof, are hereby abandoned, closed, discontinued and vacated
29 as public property.

30 INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 29th day of
31 November, 1971.
