AN ORDINANCE relating to setting a date of election for annexation of territory to Lakehaven Sewer District.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A petition was filed with the King County

Executive by the Commissioners of Lakehaven Sewer District for the annexation of territory hereinafter described, and known as North Lake, to said Lakehaven Sewer District, and the petition was submitted to the Superintendent of Elections.

SECTION 2. The Superintendent of Elections has filed with the King County Executive said petition together with his certificate stating that the petition has been examined and found to contain a sufficient number of signatures of qualified electors residing with in the territory proposed to be annexed, and the County Executive has submitted said petition and Certificate of Sufficiency to the King County Council.

of \_\_\_\_\_\_, 19\_72, as the date of hearing on said petition and has caused Notice of Hearing to be published in accordance with the law, and hearing has been held on said date.

SECTION 4. Said proposed annexation of territory to Lakehaven Sewer District will be conducive to the public health, welfare and convenience and will be of special benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 6. The boundaries of the territory to be annexed to Lakehaven Sewer District are hereby described as follows:

Beginning at the NW corner of Section 15, Township 21 1 North, Range 4 E., W.M., in King County. Washington; 2 Thence Easterly along the North line of the West  $\frac{1}{2}$  of said Section 15 to its intersection with the centerline 3 of Military Road South; 4 Thence Southerly along the centerline of said Military Road South to its intersection with the E-W centerline 5 of said Section 15; 6 Thence Westerly along said E-W centerline to its intersection with the N-S centerline of said Section 15; Thence South along said N-S centerline to the South 8 quarter corner of Section 15, also being the North quarter corner of Section 22, Township 21 North, Range 9 4 East, W.M.; 10 Thence continuing South along the N-S centerline of said Section 22 to its intersection with the centerline 11 of Primary State Highway No. 2 (SR 18); 12 Thence Southwesterly along the centerline of said Primary State Highway No. 2 to its intersection with the East line of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 13 22: 14 Thence North along said East line of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the 15 NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  and the East line of Government Lot 1 to its intersection with the North line of the South 300 feet of Government Lot 1 in said Section 22; 16 17 Thence Westerly along said North line of the South 300 feet to its intersection with the West line of said 18 Section 22; 19 Thence North along said West line to the NW corner of said Section 22, also being the SW corner of said 20 Section 15; 21 Thence continuing North along the West line of said Section 15 to the Northwest corner thereof and the 22 point of beginning. 23 SECTION 7.
