

AN ORDINANCE establishing a General Grant Fund and transferring various grant appropriations and revenues from funds as adopted in the 1972 budget to the General Grant Fund, and amending Ordinance No. 1056 and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established a General Grant Fund to consolidate miscellaneous grant appropriations and revenues from various funds within the 1972 adopted budget.

SECTION 2. The County Council finds as a fact, that such consolidation of grant funds into one General Grant Fund will improve the County's accounting system and provide visibility for the fiscal management of grants.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 1056, Section 2 and Section 3, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4. Funds reduced in Section 3, herein, in the total amount of \$992,317.70 are hereby appropriated to the General Grant Fund.

SECTION 5. Funds appropriated in Section 4, herein, shall not be expended for purposes other than specified guidelines stipulated by the Federal and State granting agencies.

SECTION 6. The County Council find, as a fact, and declares that an emergency exists and this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and the support of County government and its existing institutions.
