

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of 100th Avenue  
2 N.E. (N.E. 116th Street to Simonds Road).

3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

4 SECTION 1. That the Director of the Department of Public Works  
5 has made an examination of 100th Avenue N.E. (N.E. 116th Street to  
6 Simonds Road) along the course and description as set forth below,  
7 and had made a favorable report upon same, as required by law.

8 SECTION 2. That said road be established not less than 84 feet  
9 in width, having 42 feet of such width each side of the following  
10 described centerline:

11 Beginning at a point N. 88°55'45" W. a distance of 599.01  
12 feet from the SE section corner of Sec. 30, Twp. 26 N.,  
13 Rge. 5 E., W.M.; thence N'ly a distance of 10,022.18 feet  
14 to a terminus at the intersection of 100th Avenue N.E. and  
15 Simonds Road, said terminus being S. 0°45'45" W. a distance  
16 of 794.74 feet from the NE section corner of Sec. 19, Twp.  
17 26 N., Rge. 5 E., W.M.

18 10,022.18 feet = 1.898 miles

19 SECTION 3. That the King County Council finds that the  
20 establishment of said roadway, along the course and description set  
21 forth, is a public necessity.

22 SECTION 4. That the King County Council directs the Department  
23 of Public Works to provide in their design for the safety of the  
24 children using this road.

26 December, 1971.
