AN ORDINANCE creating King County Road Improvement District No. 57 for a Street Lighting System in the Park Orchard Area

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1: Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.015, 36.88.050, 36.88.060, et seq, it is found and declared that the petition filed for the creation of a Road Improvement District for street lights in the Park Orchard area, including all withdrawls therefrom and additions thereto made prior to 5 o'clock p.m. on the day before the Hearing, has been signed by the owners of <u>37</u> per cent of the lineal frontage upon the improvement to be made and 54per cent of the area within the limits of the Improvement District. King County Motion No. 744 on February 14, 1972, set a date for a Public Hearing to be held on March 27, 1972, for the formation of this Improvement District. The Motion was duly published and Notices of Hearing were mailed as required by law. All written and verbal protest were heard. It is further found that the plan of improvement is feasible and that the benefits derived therefrom by the property within the proposed improvement district exceed the cost and expense of the contemplated improvements; and that the estimated assessments as prepared by the Director of the Department of Public Works appear to be equitable.

Section 2: All County streets in the following plats shall be improved by the installation of street lights: Park Orchard Division No. 4 as recorded in Volume 68 of Plats, pages 58, 59 and 60; Hines Addition Division No. 1 as recorded in Volume 62 of Plats, pages 26 and 27; Hines Addition Division No. 2 as recorded in Volume 63 of Plats, pages 15 and 16; Hines Addition Division No. 3 as recorded in Volume 64 of Plats, pages 15 and 16; Oxford Addition as recorded in Volume 77 of Plats, pages 11 and 12.

Section 3: There is hereby established a Road Improvement

District in King County to be known and designated as King County

Road Improvement District No. 57 which district shall include all the property abutting upon the streets to be improved; said district includes all the County streets and lots in Park Orchard Division No. 4 as recorded in Volume 68 of Plats, pages 58, 59 and 60; Hines Addition Division No. 1 as recorded in Volume 62 of Plats, pages 26 and 27; Hines Addition Division No. 2 as recorded in Volume 63 of Plats, pages 15 and 16; Hines Addition Division No. 3 as recorded in Volume 64 of Plats, pages 15 and 16; Oxford Addition as recorded in Volume 77 of Plats, pages 11 and 12, and the unplatted one acre tract lying south of lots 61, 62 and 63 Oxford Addition known as Tax Lot 69 of Section 17, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M.

Section 4: Approximately 140 7,000 Lumen Mercury Vapor lights will be installed on existing power poles by Puget Sound Power and Light Company at no construction cost to King County or the property owners, and said street lights will remain the property of Puget Sound Power and Light Company.

Section 5: The maintenance and power cost for this improvement for one year is estimated to amount to approximately \$4,032.00. A King County Department of Finance fee of \$3.00 for each of the 497 accounts or lots will be added to the first payment, therefore, the total cost for the first year is estimated to amount to approximately \$5,523.00, or approximately \$11.11 for each of the 497 accounts or lots. It is hereby declared by the King County Council that the maintenance and power cost and the Department of Finance fee shall be borne by and assessed against the property included in the assessment district herein established. The assessments shall become due and payable during the thirty (30) day period succeeding the date of the first publication of such notice and annually thereafter each succeeding payment of approximately \$8.11 for each of the 497 accounts or lots shall be due on the anniversary date of said publication date.

Section 6: There shall be and hereby created in the Department of Finance a fund to be known as "King County Road Improvement District No. 57, Operation and Maintenance Fund". All monies collected by the Department of Finance upon any assessments levied for the operation and maintenance of said district shall be placed in said Operation and Maintenance Fund. Payment shall be made on the basis of the Maintenance Assessment Roll prepared by the Department of Public Works, subject to adjustment after completion of the Hearing on said roll.

Section 7: The Director of the Department of Public Works is hereby directed to negotiate with Puget Sound Power and Light Company for the installation and maintenance of the street lights and when the installation has been completed, said Director of the Department of Public Works is further directed to prepare and file with the King County Council Administrator-Clerk a Maintenance Assessment Roll for the maintenance assessment to be levied against the property included in the assessment district herein established.
