AN ORDINANCE accepting and confirming the Maintenance Assessment Roll for King County Road Improvement District No. 57, Street Lights in the Park Orchard area.

PREAMBLE:

In accordance with the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.090 and with King County Motion No. 923, a hearing on the Maintenance Assessment Roll of King County Road Improvement District No. 57 was held on October 24, 1972. Testimony presented at the hearing indicates that the proceedings have been conducted in conformance with applicable statutes, and that the assessments are equitable. No protests or revision of assessments have been approved by the County Council at the hearing.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1: The Maintenance Assessment Roll of King County Road Improvement District No. 57, as prepared by the Director of the Department of Public Works, and now on file with the King County Council, is hereby accepted and confirmed.

Section 2: The Maintenance Assessment Roll shall be filed with the Director of the King County Department of Finance for collection. In accordance with R.C.W. 36.88.270, the Director of the Department of Finance shall, as soon as the assessment roll has been placed in his hands for collection, publish a notice for two consecutive daily or weekly issues in the official newspaper of the County, which notice shall state that the assessment roll is in his hands for collection and that any assessment thereon may be paid at any time within thirty days from the date of the first publication of said notice without penalty. Assessments unpaid after the thirty days from the date of first publication shall be declared delinquent.

<u>Section 3</u>: The assessments shall be due and payable as follows:

The first annual maintenance assessment of \$12.65 assessed upon each lot within the assessment district, and confirmed by

this Ordinance shall be due and payable at any time within the thirty day period from the date of the first publication of the notice described herein in Section 2. Unpaid assessments after the thirty day period shall be declared delinquent. All delinquent accounts shall bear a penalty of ten percent (10%) per annum and said penalty shall be included and be a part of the assessment liem. Collection on delinquent accounts shall be enforced in the matter provided by law.

The second and succeeding annual maintenance assessment will be based on cost of maintenance and power charges of Puget Sound Power and Light Company. Prior to the second and succeeding annual maintenance assessment, a budget for Road Improvement District No. 57 will be submitted to the County Executive annually for approval. Upon approval of the annual budget for Road Improvement District No. 57, the second and succeeding annual maintenance assessment shall be due and payable annually on the anniversary date of said publication date described herein. Past due annual assessments shall be declared delinquent. All delinquent accounts shall bear a penalty of ten per cent (10%) per annum and said penalty shall be included and be a part of the assessment lien.
