

AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a 10 foot wide walkway in Tract B of the Plat of Inglewood East - - - - - V-1446.
Petitioners: J & K Homes, Inc. and others.

WHEREAS a petition has been filed requesting vacation of a 10 foot wide walkway in Tract B of the Plat of Inglewood East, hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS the report of the Department of Public Works and Transportation and the Department of Community and Environmental Development, Land Use Management Division, find that the walkway to be vacated is useless to the County, and the vacation would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the comprehensive plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of the proposed vacation, and

WHEREAS the lands being vacated were dedicated by the adjoining land owners in 1972 and these dedicated lands will revert to the owners, and

WHEREAS the vacation of the subject walkway is found to be useless to the needs of the County and the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls, and

WHEREAS due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 20th day of August, 1973, and

WHEREAS in consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of King County to grant said petition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF KING:

SECTION I:

The Council on the 20th day of August, 1973, hereby vacates and abandons the road described as follows:

Tract "B" of Inglewood East as recorded




