ORDINANCE NO. 1774

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$47,000 to the Department of Public Safety and \$10,000 to the Department of Executive Administration, Comptroller Division from unanticipated revenues for administration and collection of the gambling tax; amending Ordinance 1431, Section 2, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation in the amount of \$47,000 to the Department of Public Safety and \$10,000 to the Department of Executive Administration, Comptroller Division, from unanticipated revenues is hereby approved and adopted for the policing, administering and collecting the gambling tax on bingo and amusement games.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 1431, Section 2, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:



SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.




